"Fish In the Ocean" was supposed to be the A side from this recording session. (One of Guaranteed Record's executives blew into a water glass with a strawto produce the "Bubbly, Bum Bum" sound.) Harder than singing on "Happy-Go-Lucky Me" was laughing on it. When the record was covered in an K-Tel album knock off of the top 10 hits of the day, one performer sang the song and another laughed on it.
